Time for a Check-Up

When we began 2022, we did it with the idea of asking God to produce spiritual fruit in us. Luke 8:15 revealed that if we receive the good news of the Gospel with an "honest and good heart" and if we "hold on to it by enduring", we will "produce fruit." We then spent some time in Galatians 5:22-23 discovering what this fruit produced by the Spirit would like. The list was clear; love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, goodness, and self-control would be the result.

We are beginning the eighth month of 2022, and the questions we need to ask ourselves are, "Do I see more fruit in my life today than I did eight months ago? What is the evidence that I have honestly received the Gospel and by the power of the Spirit, it is changing me?" It's probably time for us to have a spiritual check-up, allowing the Word of God to serve as the standard for spiritual growth and health and see how we are measuring up. From my perspective as your pastor, I am seeing signs of growth and health in our congregation. There is evidence of renewed unity, a heart for the Word, and a desire to serve others. There is an affection for God and for each other, as well as our neighbors and community. Joy is evident in times of worship, and I hear kindness in much of our speech. But, what about you as an individual? What evidence is there of spiritual growth in your life? If those who know you best were to take the qualities of a spirit-led life and use them as the guide to determine your spiritual health, what would their diagnosis be? Let us all allow God's Word and Spirit to lead us in a spiritual check-up and help us determine where we are in terms of spiritual growth and maturity.
