

## Let's Give Thanks But Let's Also Get to Work...

Friday, June 24, 2022, will go down as a monumental day in the fight for the sanctity of life. The Supreme Court's decision to overturn Roe v. Wade was a huge win in the fight to end abortion, that many of us wondered if would ever happen. While this should be considered a victory and should be celebrated, it is by no means the end. For one thing, abortion is still allowed in much of the United States. Time will tell how this decision will affect the decisions that states make concerning outlawing the killing of innocent children. While we're fortunate in our state to have strict laws concerning this, we must continue to pray that other states will follow.

Without a doubt, this decision will lead to the birth of more children. While this is indeed a blessing, it will also create new needs which bring along ministry opportunities. First, how will we minister to mothers who now have a child or another child and are in difficult situations? How will we come alongside them and walk with them through what (for many) will be a scary and difficult time in their life? We cannot ignore them and fail to minister to them and serve them now that they have kept their child. We must work to find ways to care for those who are hurting and alone.

Sadly, the need for foster and adoptive homes will increase as well. This is another calling for the church to step up and get to work. As I write this, according to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services, there are 6,886 children in DHS custody in Oklahoma. There is currently a need for 805 foster families in the state. Right now, 441 children need to be placed. These numbers will, without a doubt, increase in the future. Let that sink in before you dismiss it. 441 children right now are out of their homes, away from their families, not knowing where they will spend the night and many of them are without a place for them to go. This has and will continue to be a need that the church is capable of helping with. We cannot talk about the sanctity of life, yet neglect life that needs help. We who have been adopted by God, through Jesus Christ should understand this more than anyone.

Many of our friends have children who have been adopted out of DHS custody. I have seen firsthand the difficult situations that women, children, and families find themselves in. First Moore, what will we do to help? Who will answer the call in our church to meet the need and how will we as a body serve them? May we give thanks for a step that leads to the end of the needless killing of children, but may we also get to work in caring for the children and families that are with us today.

On a final note, it is right for us to hate abortion and fight against it. It is wrong for us to hate others who are advocates for it or who have participated in it. I am ashamed of some of the ways I see Christian people talking to and about this topic on social media. We must be careful that in hating murder, we do not become guilty of it as Jesus taught in Matthew 5, when He said that if you hate another person, you are already guilty of murder in your heart. May we love continually and be agents of reconciliation in the world.
