A WORD FROM PASTOR CHARLIE

Based upon conversations I have had with many of you and my own personal experience, God is using the book of Malachi to challenge and convict many of us; revealing areas of sin that we need to turn from. It is so easy for us to go through the motions, and because our sin is not directly overt, or looks like much of what is going on in the world, feel as if we are doing okay, when in fact our hearts are far from the Lord. In grace, God confronts our sins, convicts our hearts, and calls us to return to Him. A trap that we can all fall into is acting as if conviction is enough. It's a trap that treats conviction and admission as if they are the same thing as repentance. God wants you to experience more than conviction. He wants more from us than mere acknowledgment of our sin and waywardness. He demands more than the confession that we need to change. He desires that we turn from our sin and turn back to him in a heart of repentance.
