By now, you have probably heard that there is a more permanent change to our Sunday morning schedule. Moving forward, we will continue in one service at 10:30am with Life Groups meeting before at 9:15am. Six weeks ago, we began meeting in one service as we discussed what it means to be the Household of God. This was intentional, as I felt that it was necessary for us to talk about being the church as the church gathered together. My hope was that it would ignite a desire in us for unity that would possibly lead to uniting our services and breaking down the barriers of age and preferred musical style in our church. I am a firm believer that the gospel unites, and our two services didn't seem to tell that story. As we have talked about defining church in a Biblical way, we've seen that we are a people who have been called out by God, set apart by God, to gather and assemble for the worship of God, while then being sent out into the world to proclaim God's Gospel that others might believe and be gathered with us. May we strive together, abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing our labor is not in vain.
