A WORD FROM PASTOR CHARLIE

For the Future Update

At the end of 2021, our body affirmed moving forward with a proposal to complete the replacement of the HVAC equipment on our church campus. This means that all of our HVAC units have been replaced in the last five years. Many of these units were failing and in dire need of replacement. Our church approved borrowing up to 1.5 million dollars to complete this project. I am glad to report to you that the units have been replaced, and the project only cost \$1,356,707.00. Through your generous giving, we only have a debt of \$800,000.00, which means we have paid nearly half a million dollars of these expenses with funds on hand! (We do have a remaining balance of \$68,000.00 that we will pay once the project is complete.) We are thankful for how you have given up to this point and ask that you would continue to generously give to help us pay off the remaining balance.

At the same time, our body affirmed moving forward with a much-needed update and remodel of our worship center. We have been patiently waiting for the architectural firm that began drawing the plans in 2018, to help us re-engage the project and bring it to completion. We are pleased to share with you that at the end of September, Church Leadership and the Steering Committee will begin meeting with the firm again to finish the design and complete the plans. This is exciting and important for the future of our church. Not only is our worship center dated in its appearance, but much of our current audio-visual equipment is beginning to fail and is unable to meet the needs of our church today and into the future.

I share all of this with you to keep you informed of where we are in the process and to assure you that we are still working, albeit at a slower pace than we had originally hoped. We will bring proposals and recommendations for church affirmation in the future, when the time is appropriate, so we can move
